RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Commissioner's Court has the obligation to determine the acquisition, retrofitting, renovation, and equipping of county offices including the renovation of the existing courthouse; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Commissioners' Court have considered the necessity of additional space for county government operations due to the population growth of the county; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Commissioners' Court has the opportunity to acquire 1930 N. Trade Days Boulevard as an annex to the County Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, said building will need renovation which is not currently in the existing FY25 budget; and

WHEREAS, there has been considerable discussion among the citizens of Van Zandt County about how to raise money for renovating any future county buildings which may either be through certificates of obligation or via a bond election; and


WHEREAS, after discussion in a public forum considering both of these options;

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED

That the Van Zandt County Commissioners' Court, having considered the options and potential for renovating the 1930 N. Trade Days Blvd and the existing courthouse resolves that if a tax increase would be necessary for renovation of any County building, the Commissioners Court will propose a bond election, and not issue or propose a Certificate of Obligation, which the citizens of Van Zandt County shall vote to approve or deny.
