BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

1. The position of Full-Time Juvenile Supervision Officer I required under Texas Administrative Code, Title 37 Public Safety and Corrections part XI, Texas Juvenile Probation Commission Chapter 343, Section 3: An incumbent to comply with State standards and be of good moral character.
2. Possess a high school education or equivalent. College Degree preferred.
3. Must be 21 years of age.
4. Be willing to obtain additional training, skills, experience and certifications as the Texas Juvenile Justice Department prescribes.

BASIC QUALIFICIATONS: Continued...

5. Possess the ability to write accurate behavioral notes, incident reports, and disciplinary plans on supervising children within the facility.
6. Be physically able to handle contingencies that arise in a detention setting.
7. Be willing to work shift work.
8. Experience in Juvenile Detention work preferred.
9. Supervisory experience preferred.
10. Successfully pass physical, urinalysis and thorough background investigation.

EXAMPLES OF JOB DUTIES:

1. Supervise youth ages 10 through 16, temporarily detained awaiting court hearings and residents in Secure Residential Program.
2. Provide a safe and therapeutic environment for youth temporarily detained awaiting court hearings.
3. Monitor all activities to ensure that the safety of the youth and security of the facility is maintained.
4. Coordinate and supervise building clean up to constantly maintain building cleanliness.
5. Required to arrange, monitor, and supervise group activities.
6. Provide and coordinate effective corrective action and counseling in emergency situations.
7. Any other duties as assigned by Supervisor.

Full Time \$ 30,592/Annual Salary
